This meme discusses the structural racism of a number of modern feminist ideologies. Much of the information in this meme comes from Srivastava's (2005) work, in which she discusses how the feminist movement evolved from the blatant racism of the first wave to the concealed racism of the second wave. Srivastava calls this concealed racism "nonracism". She says that nonracism, unlike antiracism, involves a willful blindness to race and racism. Nonracists refuse to see themselves as implicated in white supremacy and reply to charges of racism with defensiveness, anger, sadness, and shock. Nonracists believe that having sympathy for POC and being supposedly surprised by blatant displays of racism is sufficient to "fix" the problem of racism.
